5 Yr. Old Boy Struck by Motorcycle Dies

Washington (AP) - A 5-year-old boy died Friday from injuries suffered when he was hit by a motorcycle.

Lawrence Yelverton and Charles Fenwick, 4, were hit Thursday afternoon in the courtyard of the Woodland Terrace housing complex in Southeast Washington, police said. Yelverton died early Friday at Children's Hospital. Fenwick remained in critical condition Friday.

Officers recovered a red and white "dirt bike" style motorcycle believed to have been involved in the fatal crash a short distance away.

Police searched door-to-door in the neighborhood for the driver.

The two boys and five other children were walking with an adult caregiver from Stanton Elementary School to Young's Memorial Day Care Learning Center on Alabama Avenue, S.E., less than a half-mile away, The Washington Post reported.

Officials at the day care center said the caregiver took a detour through the housing complex, apparently to take one of the children home. The caregiver has been suspended while police investigate.
